

Dad's will from LORRA COMINOVS
~3-15-64

I, HENRY J. HOFFMAN, of the Borough of St. Marys, County of Elk and State of Pennsylvania, being of sound mind, memory and understanding, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void any and all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST: I will and direct that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as may be convenient.

SECOND: I direct my executors hereinafter named to expend the sum of fifty dollars for Masses to be read for the repose of my soul.

THIRD: It is my will that any of my children who shall have purchased household furniture, furnishings, equipment, tools or any other articles of personal property, which may be located at my home, shall have the right and privilege of claiming the same as their own, and to remove the same at their will or pleasure.

FOURTH: I give, devise and bequeath unto my son JOSEPH G. HOFFMAN any automobile as may be registered in my name at the time of my decease. This bequest is made in consideration of the fact that my said son has always maintained my automobile for me without expense to me.

FIFTH: I give, devise and bequeath unto my daughter, MARIE T. HOFFMAN, all of my U.S. Government war bonds that are registered in the joint names of myself and my said daughter. This bequest is made in consideration of the fact that she had taken care of my home for me during my lifetime.

SIXTH: I give, devise and bequeath all the remainder, rest and residue of my estate, be the same real, personal or mixed property, unto my son JOSEPH G. HOFFMAN and my daughter MARIE T. HOFFMAN, trustees, in trust for the following uses and purposes, -

CODICIL

(a) I will and direct that my trustees shall use the income of my estate and so much of the principal as may be necessary for the purpose of providing proper support and maintenance for my minor children until they respectively arrive at the age of twenty one years. Should any of my said minor children be employed, they shall be entitled to keep their wages but it is my desire that they shall live at home and pay board in a proper amount as it is my wish that all of my children, including those who have reached their majority, shall live together in order to help support the younger children and keep my home intact.

(b) It is my will that, after the youngest of my children shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years, my trustees are directed to divide the sum remaining in their hands among all my children, share and share alike. This distribution shall include the sale of my real estate which is to be sold in accordance with the next succeeding paragraph.

(c) I will and direct that my said trustees, who are also executors of this my last will, shall have the right and privilege to sell my real estate at any time when, in their opinion, it is for the best interest of my estate to do so at public or private sale at the highest obtainable price, without asking leave of Court, and to give a good and sufficient Deed of General Warranty therefor, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the trust above stated. When and after the youngest of my children shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years, my said executors and trustees are authorized and directed to sell all of my real estate with the same rights and privileges as hereinbefore stated; this power of sale being given for the purpose of making distribution as provided for in sub-division (b) hereinabove stated.
