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## Summary Report

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The goal of this project was to discover what happened to **Jacques (Jacob) Kettering**, born on 26 April 1850 in Nehwiller-pres-Woerth.

### Background

You requested my assistance by email on 11 November 2025, asking for me to find any trace in America of Jacques (Jacob) Kettering, with the following details specified:

- Born: 26 April 1850, in Nehwiller near Woerth
- Married to Louise Mori on 24 April 1876, in Nehwiller near Woerth
- Possibly immigrated to America after January 1879, possibly to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

### Summary of findings

I did locate an individual that is very likely the same Jacob Kettering in the Pittsburgh area. He reports a matching month and year of birth on the 1900 U.S. Census, at which time he is living on Natchez Street in Pittsburgh with a wife named Wilhelmina, and two daughters named Sophia and Mary. His death record on 11 January 1919 also reports the same birth date, giving me high confidence that the correct individual is located.

His Declaration of Intent to Naturalize on 30 March 1896 provides an arrival date of 4 March 1881 in New York, which sufficiently matches a passenger list that indicates arrival in New York City on 7 March 1881 on a ship originating from La Havre, France. He appears without a spouse or any children on the passenger list, appearing to be traveling with a 17 year male named Antonie Lugman.

I did not locate any records associated with the first spouse, Louise Mori. She likely died prior to 6 December 1894, because on that date Jacob married a Wilhelmina Lutz, and it indicates on

that marriage record that both he and Wilhelmina had previous spouses who were deceased. Jacob did have two daughters living with him in the 1900 census, a Sophia Kettering born 1878, and a Mary Kettering born November 1885. Both daughters are indicated as having been born in Pennsylvania, although it seems likely that Sophia was actually born back in Europe since her birth appears to be prior to her father's immigration date.

Jacob appears on city directories in 1897 and 1899, and in both he is indicated as living at 41 Natchez Street in Pittsburgh, and working as a laborer. In the 1900 census he is still living at the same location, and his occupation is listed as a Boat Fireman.

I did not find him in the 1910 census. I searched the database with a variety of permutations of the name, but did not find any likely candidates for him. That may suggest that he was not in the Pittsburgh area in 1910, and a wider search would be necessary to locate him.

His death record indicates that he died on 11 January 1919, a widower, from cirrhosis of the liver, at Allegheny County Home in Woodville, a Pennsylvania, and that he was buried on 13 January 1919.

### **Further avenues of research**

Jacob's whereabouts in the 1910 census remain unknown, and locating him in that census could help find out whether he spent any significant time elsewhere other than Pittsburgh after immigrating there in 1881.

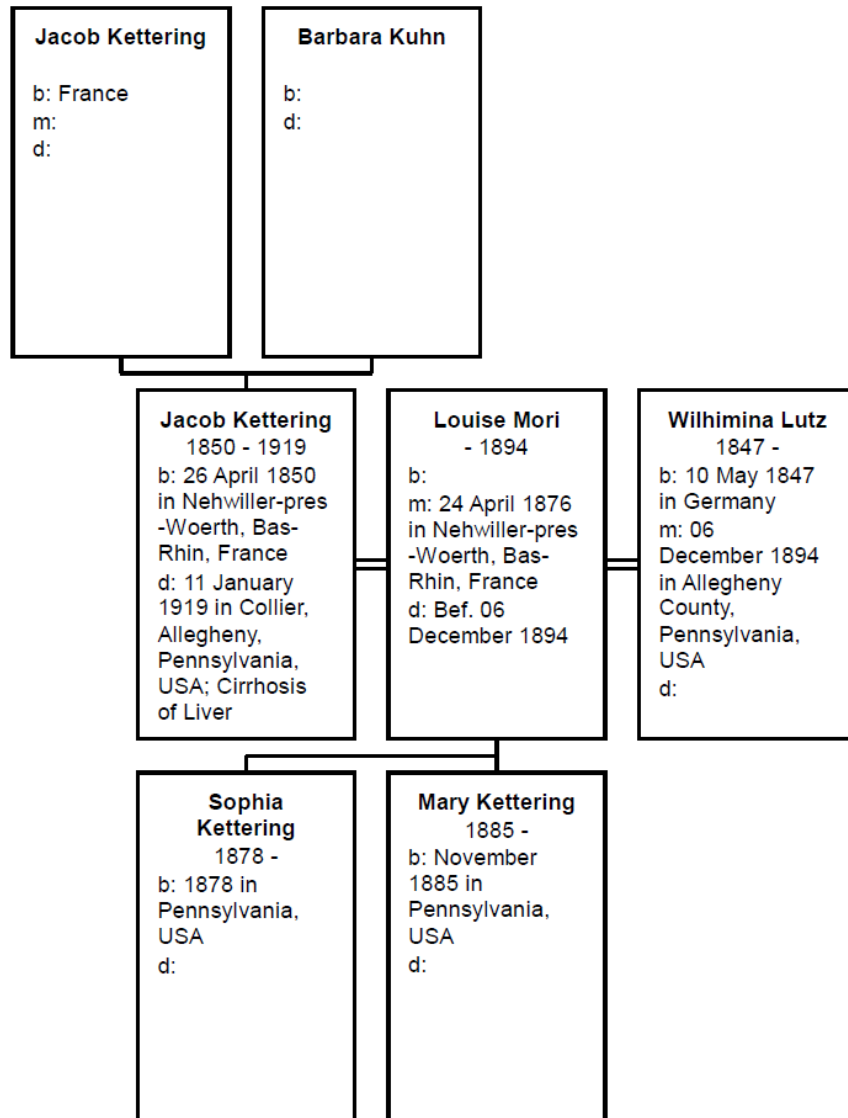
The fate of the first wife, Louise Mori, remains largely unknown, besides her having died prior to Jacob's remarriage in 1894. Further research could yield confirmation whether she also immigrated separately to America, and whether Sophia and Mary were her progeny.

Further research could be conducted on the daughters, Sophia and Mary, and other children of Jacob may be possible.

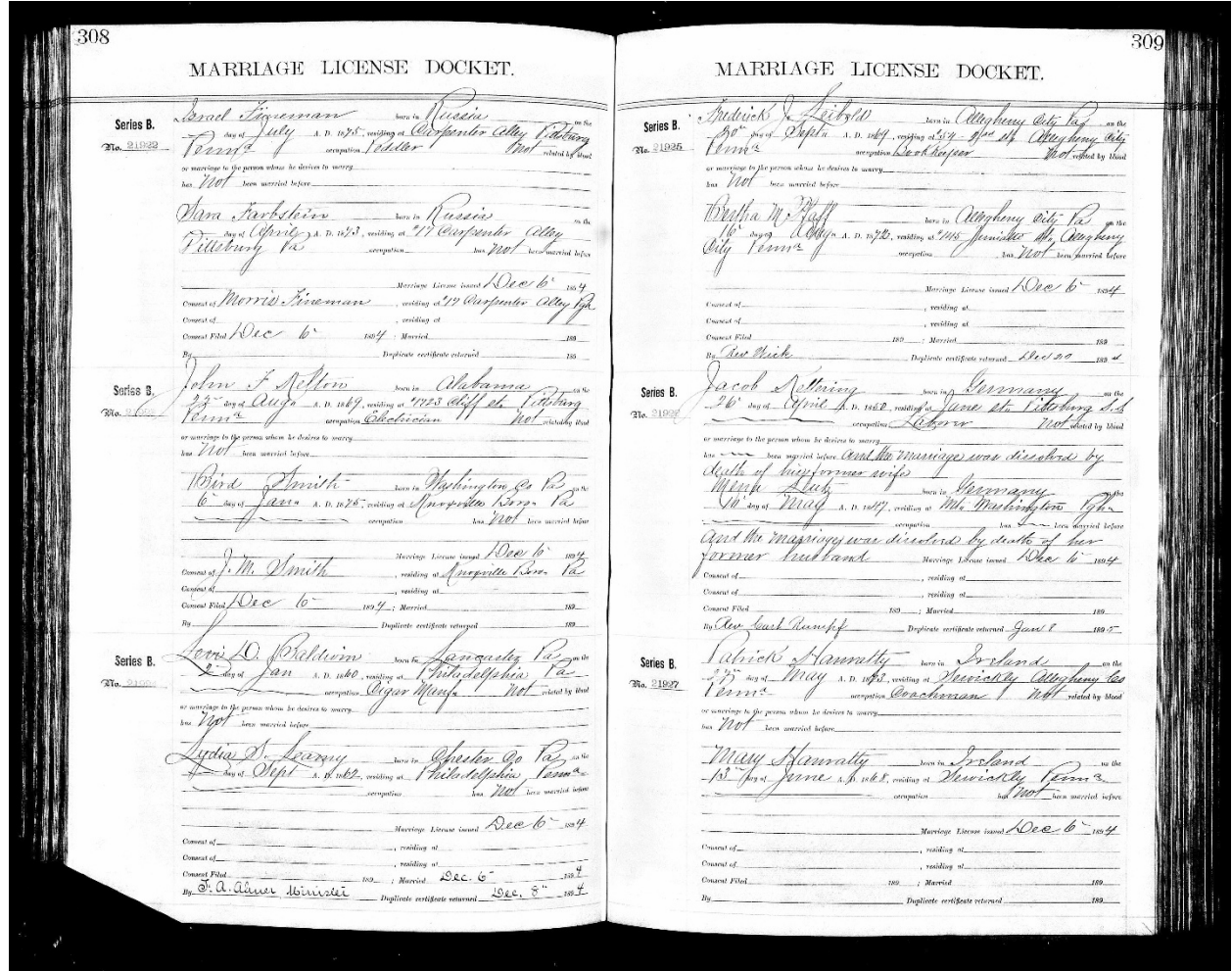
